

RESOLUTION No. 549

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

MARCH 5, 1948.

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works, Division of Highways, of the State of California, has given its consent in writing for the establishment of a "NO PARKING" area hereinafter set out adjacent to the intersection at Stockton Boulevard and 14th Avenue, in this city, where electric traffic signals are now being erected and upon recommendation of the Superintendent of Streets and the City Traffic Engineer,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That the following area be and the same is hereby fixed and designated as a "NO PARKING" area for motor vehicles, particularly described as follows:

Along the curb lines in the northeast quadrant of Stockton Boulevard and 14th Avenue, between points 76 feet east of and 32 feet north of where the prolongation of the straightaway curb lines in said quadrant intersect. Along the curb lines in the northwest quadrant of Stockton Boulevard and 14th Avenue, between points 40 feet west of and 66 feet north of where the prolongation of the straightaway curb lines in said quadrant intersect.

That this resolution is made pursuant to the written consent of the Department of Public Works as provided by the provisions of the Motor Vehicle Code, and that upon the establishment of proper markings, parking in said area shall be prohibited.
