

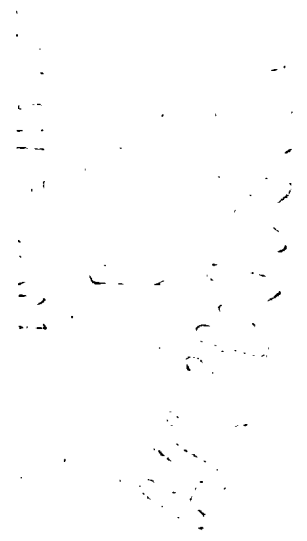
**Resolved**, that the City Council of the City of Sacramento, having in open session on the **8th** day of **September**, **1927**, opened, examined, and publicly declared all sealed proposals or bids offered for the doing of the street work hereinafter mentioned,

Hereby rejects all of said bids, except that next hereinafter mentioned, and hereby awards the contract for said work to the lowest regular, responsible bidder, to-wit:

To **A. TEICHERT & SON, INC.**,

at the prices specified in **its** proposal for said work now on file.

The work herein referred to is the improvement of **Jeffery Avenue and Pacific Avenue, from the southerly line of Sutterville Road to the southerly boundary of the City of Sacramento; the southerly side of Sutterville Road, from the alley first west of Jeffery Avenue to the alley first east of Pacific Avenue; and the alley first east of Pacific Avenue, from the southerly curb line of Sutterville Road to Power Company's pole first south of Sutterville Road,**



in the City of Sacramento to the extent, with the materials and in the manner set forth in Resolution of Intention No. **2195**, passed and adopted by said City Council on **July 14**, **1927**; reference to which Resolution of Intention is hereby made for a description of said work and improvement, **and of the district to be assessed for the costs and expenses of said work.**

The City Clerk is hereby directed to publish notice of this award twice in the **Sacramento Bee**, a daily newspaper published and circulated in said City of Sacramento, as required by law.
