RESOLUTION OF WAIVER OF LIQUIDATED DAMAGES

WHEREAS, Campbell Construction Company entered into a contract with the City of Sacramento for reconstruction of old pretreatment works, Sacramento Filtration Plant, Docket No. Calif 1293-F, which contains a provision for \$10.00 per day for each day over the time specified for completion as liquidated damages, and


WHEREAS, said company has asked for an extension of time of 31 days which is additional to the 39 days granted by Resolution No. 259, passed May 7, 1936, specifying good and sufficient reason therefor,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That said Campbell Construction Company be, and it is hereby, allowed said 31 additional days for completion of the said reconstruction and that, in view of the premises, the said provision concerning liquidated damages is hereby waived.
