- ▶ It is customary for the City Clerk to be authorized to transmit any measure(s) to the City Attorney for preparation of an impartial analysis to be included in the Official Sample Ballot for a forthcoming election.
- ▶ The impartial analysis shall not exceed 500 words in length, and will precede the arguments for and against the measure(s) in the Official Sample Ballot.
- ▶ The deadline for the City Attorney's return of the impartial analysis to the Office of the City Clerk is no later than Monday, March 9, 1998.

There is no financial impact associated with this item.


POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:
