SUBJECT: Appropriation of Funds and Recommendation of Bid Award for the
Sutterville South Drainage Project

SUMMARY

The subject project, as a part of the City's capital improvement program, has been advertised for bids. Bids have been received and the City Engineer hereby recommends that additional Sewer Funds be appropriated and that the project be awarded to the low bidder.

BACKGROUND

On February 19, 1980, the City Council approved plans and specifications for the Sutterville South Drainage Project and bids were received and opened by the City Clerk in the Council Chambers on March 18, 1980. Bids received are as follows:

FINANCIAL DATA

In FY 1979/80, the City Council approved \$220,000 in the Capital Improvement Budget from Sewer Funds for the subject project, of which \$198,870.63 is currently available as of February 22, 1980. Total project costs are estimated as follows:



Additional funds are required in the amount of \$153,078.00, which would leave a balance of \$3,376,020 in the Sewer Fund.

RECOMMENDATION


