

# RESOLUTION No. 328

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

November 7, 1935

WHEREAS, a consolidated Regular and Special Municipal Election was held in the City of Sacramento on the 7th day of November, 1935, pursuant to provisions of Ordinance No. 678, Fourth Series adopted by the City Council on date of October 4, 1935, at which certain proposed Propositions for the incurring of bonded indebtedness against the City of Sacramento were submitted to the qualified electors of the City of Sacramento; and

WHEREAS, the vote and returns of said election have this day been canvassed by the City Council of the City of Sacramento convening as a Canvassing Board and the results thereof duly ascertained other than the ballots of absentee voters;
