STREET, ADOPTED APRIL 22ND, 1965


RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:


That the following Resolutions of this Council are hereby

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Improvement Act of 1931 proceedings for the construction of the works and improvements in the Southerly one-half of Florin Road from Amherst Street to 17th Street, described in Resolution of Intention No. 3766, adopted on March 25th, 1965, are hereby abandoned.
