Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

June 27, 1929


(Introduced by Councilman Campbell)

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 383, 3rd Series regulating signs and billboards was adopted by City Council more than ten years ago and has become inoperative and obsolete in many respects; and

WHEREAS, the Sign and Billboard industry has proposed many new types and styles of signs not covered thereby.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the matter of drafting an up-to-date Ordinance be referred to City Manager for investigation and presentation of an amended or new ordinance which will adequately cover the regulation of signs and billboards in the City of Sacramento.
