RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING RIGHT-OF-WAY DEED

WHEREAS, application has been made to the City Council by the PACIFIC GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY and PACIFIC TELEPHONE & TELEGRAPH COMPANY for a right-of-way over, through and under the

East four (4) feet of LOTS 163, 171 and 175 "SMITH TRACT NO. 4" (as the same is shown on the official map or plat thereof filed in the office of the Recorder of Sacramento County, California)


owned by the City of Sacramento, for the purpose of installing and maintaining therein power poles with necessary cross-arms and transmission wires;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO that said right-of-way be, and the same is, hereby granted; and the Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute and deliver to the said PACIFIC GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY and PACIFIC TELEPHONE & TELEGRAPH COMPANY a Deed conveying such right-of-way.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that foregoing grant of easement is non-exclusive.
