WHEREAS, both cities have adopted Riverfront Master Plans calling for improvements that enhance public access and enjoyment of the riverfront; and


WHEREAS, it is in the interest of both cities to coordinate efforts to facilitate the permitting of desirable riverfront projects, to seek grant funds to further improve the riverfront, and to work together to promote riverfront projects.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Sacramento hereby agrees to cooperate with the City of West Sacramento as follows:

1. To explore the possibility of formulating and introducing state legislation for the 2001/02 session modifying development restrictions applying to the 3.5 miles of Sacramento Riverfront described in the Joint Waterfront Master Plans; the east bank from Discovery Park to Miller Park and the west bank from Lighthouse Marina to Stone Lock.
2. To jointly seek federal funding of improvements to the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers hydraulic model of the Sacramento River within the general area described above.
3. To jointly seek federal and state grant funds for projects included in the two cities' Riverfront Master Plans and coordinate the efforts of each city's state and federal lobbyists and elected officials in that regard.
4. To direct the Waterfront Advisory Committee to evaluate and establish priorities for future waterfront projects and provide advice to the City Councils on project advocacy, legislative matters and grant applications.


