

RESOLUTION ORDERING WORK NO. 3618

RESOLVED, that the public interest and convenience require, and the City Council of the City of Sacramento hereby orders, the following work to be done, to-wit:


The improvement of Campbell Lane from the centerline of Lucio Lane to a point located 205 feet Southerly therefrom,


in the City of Sacramento, to the extent, with the materials and in the manner set forth in RESOLUTION OF INTENTION NO. 3618, passed and adopted by said City Council on October 11th, 1962, reference to which Resolution of Intention is hereby made for a description of said work and improvement.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to post conspicuously for five (5) days on or near the Council Chamber door of the City Council notice hereof, with specifications, inviting sealed proposals or bids for doing said work; and to publish twice a notice hereof, inviting sealed proposals or bids for doing said work, and referring to the specifications posted and on file, the said publication to be in the Sacramento Union, a daily newspaper, published and circulated in said City of Sacramento and hereby designated for that purpose.

All such proposals or bids shall be received by the City Clerk, at his office in the City Hall of said City, up to the hour of 5:00 o'clock P. M., on the date of November 20th, 1962, and said day is hereby designated as the day on which at the hour of 7:45 o'clock P. M., the said proposals or bids shall be opened, all of which shall be specified in said notice, and said notice shall require with said proposals or bids a check certified by a responsible bank, payable to the City of Sacramento, for an amount not less than ten per cent (10%) of the aggregate of the proposal, or by a bond for the said amount, and so payable, signed by the bidder and two sureties, all as prescribed by law.
