

RESOLUTION No. 269.

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

December 19, 1929.

RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 203, ADOPTED AUGUST 8, 1929, AND ENTITLED: "RESOLUTION FIXING THE CHARGES FOR THE USE OF THE SACRAMENTO MUNICIPAL AUDITORIUM, AND PROVIDING FOR ITS OPERATION," BY ADDING A NEW PARAGRAPH THERETO, NUMBERED 19, CONCERNING DOUBLING OF CHARGES FOR PUBLIC DANCES OF THE EVE OF HOLIDAYS.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That a new section to Resolution No. 203 be added, to read as follows:

19. The rates hereinabove provided shall be doubled on Saturdays nights or on the eve of a holiday to all individuals, clubs or organizations where floor is to be used for dancing and where admission is charged and open to the public.

This paragraph shall not apply where the club or organization excludes the general public and permits its own membership only to attend such functions.

This resolution shall become effective thirty days after adoption and passage of same.
