EXECUTE A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT FOR THE 65TH STREET STATION AREA STUDY (PN: TH16)

BACKGROUND

- A. The 65th Street Station Area Study will develop a recommended circulation system that will improve the connectivity within the Study Area to enhance the movement of people, goods, and services. This planned circulation system and land use program shall better encourage pedestrian-friendly, transit-oriented development.
- B. The 65th Street Station Area Study will develop a clear program of improvements to serve as the basis for a fee district that articulates the scope and timing of necessary transportation-related infrastructure improvements for the entire study area and establishes preliminary cost estimates that would provide a basis for establishing an equitable funding mechanism.
- C. The 65th Street Station Area Study was advertised and bids were received on January 26, 2007. The consultant team led by BMS Design Group was the chosen consultant team.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to execute an agreement with BMS Design Group for the 65th Street Station Area Study, for an amount not to exceed \$918,930..


