SUBJECT: Revocable Encroachment Permit - Bob Erickson

SUMMARY

Mr. Bob Erickson has applied for a revocable encroachment permit for the purpose of constructing PCC sidewalk and asphalt parking lot. The City Engineer recommends that the permit be granted.

RESOLUTION GRANTING REVOCABLE ENCROACHMENT TO:

Bob Erickson

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That a revocable encroachment permit for the purpose of
constructing PCC sidewalk and asphalt parking lot

is hereby granted to Bob Erickson, whose
address is as follows: 801 Riverside Avenue, Roseville, CA.

The encroachment area is described as follows:

An area 28'6" x 622' on the south side of Folsom Blvd. between
60th Street and 61st Street, beginning at 60th Street and
proceeding east.

This permit is granted subject to the "General Provisions -
Revocable Encroachment Permit", which were adopted by the City Council
in Resolution No. 77-611 dated October 4, 1977, and the hereinafter
specified special conditions, if any. This permit shall be effective only
after the applicant files with the Department of Finance of the City of
Sacramento, the insurance certificates required by the General Provisions.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

1. The Permittee shall follow the approved plan on file in the office
of the City Engineer.
2. The Permittee shall construct said improvements to City standards
and comply with all requirements of the City Inspectors.
