

**Resolution No. 2018-0482**

**Fiscal Year (FY) 2017/2018 Citizens' Option for Public Safety (COPS) Growth Program**

**BACKGROUND**

- A. California Government Code Section 30029.05 establishes extended funding in the Enhancing Law Enforcement Activities Growth Special Account and thereafter in each county treasury for the purpose of the Citizens' Option for Public Safety (COPS) Growth Program and requires monies from this fund to be distributed amongst the cities within the county in accordance with the relative population of each incorporated city.
- B. The Enhancing Law Enforcement Activities Growth Special Account for the Citizens' Option for Public Safety falls one Fiscal Year (FY) behind. The Growth funds are from FY 2018 and deposited in FY 2019. The City of Sacramento's FY18 growth allocation is \$367,710.

**BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

- Section 1. The City Manager, or the City Manager's designee is authorized to accept \$367,710 of FY 2017/18 COPS Growth funding from the County of Sacramento;
- Section 2. The City Manager, or the City Manager's designee, is authorized to establish an operating grant project (G11017400) for FY2017/18 COPS Growth;
- Section 3. The City Manager, or the City Manager's designee, is authorized to establish the necessary operating grant expense and revenue budgets up to \$367,710 in the FY18 Growth grant project (G11017400); and
- Section 4. The City Manager, or the City Manager's designee, is authorized to adjust the necessary operating grant expense and revenue budgets in the FY18

COPS Growth Program (G11017400), based on actual disbursements received.
