

# RESOLUTION No. 185

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

June 6th, 1929

WHEREAS, there is annually a loss of many lives, mostly young boys, from drowning in the Sacramento and American Rivers; and


WHEREAS, the peril and danger of swimming in these streams are not generally known or warning thereagainst given; and

WHEREAS, this usual sacrifice of human life can be materially minimized or almost entirely eliminated by a united effort of various bodies of the City by education, warnings and safeguards,


THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council hereby extends all possible cooperation in matter; and

RESOLVED FURTHER that the City Manager be directed to prepare and present to this Council a general plan and program which can be adopted by and participated in by all organizations and individuals concerned.
