

RESOLUTION NO. 741

RESOLUTION ACCEPTING GRANT DEED

WHEREAS, J. L. BUSSELL and MARY E. BUSSELL

have made, executed and delivered to the City of Sacramento a certain ^{Grant} Deed, conveying to the City of Sacramento the following real property in the City of Sacramento, County of Sacramento, State of California, bounded and particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the southwest corner of Lot 13 "Sunset Addition" (as the same is shown on the official map or plat thereof filed in the office of the County Recorder of Sacramento County, California, on May 10, 1907, in Book 8 of Maps, Map No. 26); which point is further described as being located north, $83^{\circ} 34.16'$ east, 140.26 feet from a monument marking the new center line intersection of San Jose Way (north of 5th Avenue) and 5th Avenue, in said City of Sacramento; thence from the point of beginning north, $2^{\circ} 10.44'$ west, 15.21 feet along the westerly line of said Lot 13, to a point; thence south $89^{\circ} 08.24'$ east, 40.01 feet along a line parallel to, and distant 35.00 feet at right angles northerly from, the new center line of said 5th Avenue, to a point on the easterly line of said Lot 13; thence south, $2^{\circ} 10.44'$ east, 14.67 feet along the easterly line of said Lot 13, to the southeast corner thereof; thence north $89^{\circ} 54.17'$ west, 39.99 feet along the southerly line of said Lot 13, to the point of beginning; and containing 598.00 square feet, more or less;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That the said ^{Grant} Deed be, and the same is, hereby accepted; the City Clerk being directed to attach certified copy hereof to the said ^{Grant} Deed, and record same in the office of the Sacramento County Recorder.
