SUBJECT: 1981-82 Community Development Block Grant Activities to be Implemented by the Redevelopment Agency and Housing Authority of the City of Sacramento

SUMMARY

This report regards a resolution authorizing the Redevelopment Agency and Housing Authority of the City of Sacramento to implement specified 1981-82 Community Development activities for which the City of Sacramento has received federal funds pursuant to the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program.

The staff recommends that the City Council adopt the attached resolution.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The City of Sacramento's 1981-82 CDBG Application was approved by the Department of Housing and Urban Development on June 12, 1981. The Application involves numerous projects to be undertaken and completed by the Redevelopment Agency and Housing Authority.

On December 1, 1976, the City executed the Agreements No. 76-129 and 76-130. The Agreements set forth the terms and conditions that the City and Agency will follow in transferring Community Development Block Grant funds to the Agency and Housing Authority to carry out projects pursuant to the CDBG Program.

The attached resolution authorizes the Redevelopment Agency and Housing Authority to implement specified Community Development activities pursuant to City Agreements No. 76-129 and 76-130.



A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY AND THE HOUSING AUTHORITY TO EXECUTE 1981-82 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROJECTS:
