SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF PROPOSED TOW SERVICES AGREEMENTS

SUMMARY:

The Police Department is proposing to enter into the City's new tow services agreements for FY'98-99. As proposed, the agreements are a means through which the Police Department can continue to improve customer service and maintain tow operator accountability.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Tow operators within the City limits were given an opportunity to submit a proposal to be placed on the Police Department's Tow Rotation Program.

The mission of the Sacramento Police Department is to work in partnership with the Community to protect life and property; solve neighborhood problems, and enhance the quality of life in our City.

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These proposals were evaluated on the basis of proposer's tow rates, technical compliance with the specifications outlined in the RFP, demonstrated competence, and personnel experience.

Reasonableness of the submitted rates were determined by comparing the proposer's rates with other rates charged in the City of Sacramento for identical towing services.

The tow services agreements will take effect July 1, 1998.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

No additional funding is requested.

ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:

This report does not involve an activity which would be covered by California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA).


POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:
