SUBJECT: Approval of Plans and Specifications for 13th and I Streets Fire Preemption

SUMMARY:

Plans and Specifications for this project have been prepared and copies forwarded to the City Clerk. Approval of the plans and specifications and authorization to advertise for bids is recommended.

BACKGROUND:

The use of the new Fire Station No. 2 at 13th and I, will require modification to the traffic signal system to enable safe traffic conditions when the fire equipment is responding to a fire. This project will provide such capability.

FINANCIAL:

The City Council has approved \$720,000 in the Public Works Budget from General Funds for the subject project. The total amount currently available for the project is \$91,000. The estimated construction cost is \$20,000.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the plans and specifications be approved and the City Clerk be authorize to advertise for bids to received on February 12, 1985.
