

# RESOLUTION No. 808

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of  
November 13, 1937

WHEREAS, a Special Municipal Election, consolidated with a Regular Municipal Election, was held in the City of Sacramento on the 2nd day of November, 1937, pursuant to provisions of Resolution No. 762 adopted on date of September 10, 1937, and in accordance with provisions of Section 8, Article XI of the Constitution of the State of California, for the purpose of and at which election the City Council of the City of Sacramento did, upon its own motion, submit to the qualified electors of the City of Sacramento the following Proposals, numbered "1" to "7", inclusive, for the amendment of certain sections of the Sacramento City Charter effective June 30, 1921; viz:

- PROPOSAL NO. 1: Providing for Ordinance Codes.  
PROPOSAL NO. 2: Relating to Proportional Representation System.  
PROPOSAL NO. 3: Relating to Proportional Representation Voting  
PROPOSAL NO. 4: Relating to Order of names on ballot.  
PROPOSAL NO. 5: Relating to regulation of elections.  
PROPOSAL NO. 6: Relating to Canvass of Votes.  
PROPOSAL NO. 7: Relating to Municipal Bond Elections.

AND WHEREAS, the vote and returns of said election have this day been canvassed by the City Council of the City of Sacramento convening as a Canvassing Board and the results thereof duly ascertained.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND DECLARED that the total number of ballots cast by electors at said election was 22771 ; that the aggregate of the votes cast for and against said Proposals, respectively, was 93308 ; that the number of votes cast for and against said Proposals, respectively, was as follows:

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND DECLARED that less than a majority of the qualified electors voting on Proposal No. 4 voted in favor thereof, and that said Proposal was therefor not adopted.


AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND DECLARED that Proposals, 1, 2, 3, 5, 6, and 7 received, respectively, a majority of the votes

cast therefor at said election and by reason thereof have been ratified and adopted by the electorate of the City of Sacramento.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND DECLARED that the City Attorney be and he is hereby directed to submit the necessary notice of such action for The People of the City of Sacramento to the State Legislature at its next session for ratification by said body as required by law.
