

RESOLUTION NO. 2005-648

APPROVING APPROPRIATION OF MEASURE A FUNDS (FUND 201) FOR PEDESTRIAN MASTER PLAN (PN: TY11)

BACKGROUND

- A. Due to availability of new information, the scope of work for the Pedestrian Master Plan has been modified to place more focus on policy recommendations, capital improvements and cost estimates.
- B. In order to complete the additional tasks, the project schedule and budget have to be modified. The additional work will increase the project budget by \$70,000.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The FY05/06 Capital Improvement Program budget is amended by appropriating \$70,000 (Fund 201) to the Pedestrian Master Plan Project (PN: TY11).
- Section 2. Staff is directed to bring a Measure A (Fund 201) reallocation request in the amount of \$70,000 to the Sacramento Transportation Authority (STA) Board for approval.
