SUBJECT: Revocable Encroachment Permit - State of California

SUMMARY:

The State of California has applied for a revocable encroachment permit for the purpose of constructing two pedestrian warning signs and exposed aggregate concrete and tile sidewalk paving. The City Engineer recommends that the permit be granted.

BACKGROUND:

The area for which this request is being made consists of an area between the corners of 9th Street and O Street; 9th and P Streets in the block bounded by 9th and 10th, O and P Streets. The area is approximately 860' x 16' or 13,760 sq. ft.

RECOMMENDATION:

The City Engineer recommends that the attached resolution be passed granting a revocable encroachment permit to the State of California in the area and for the purpose outlined above.

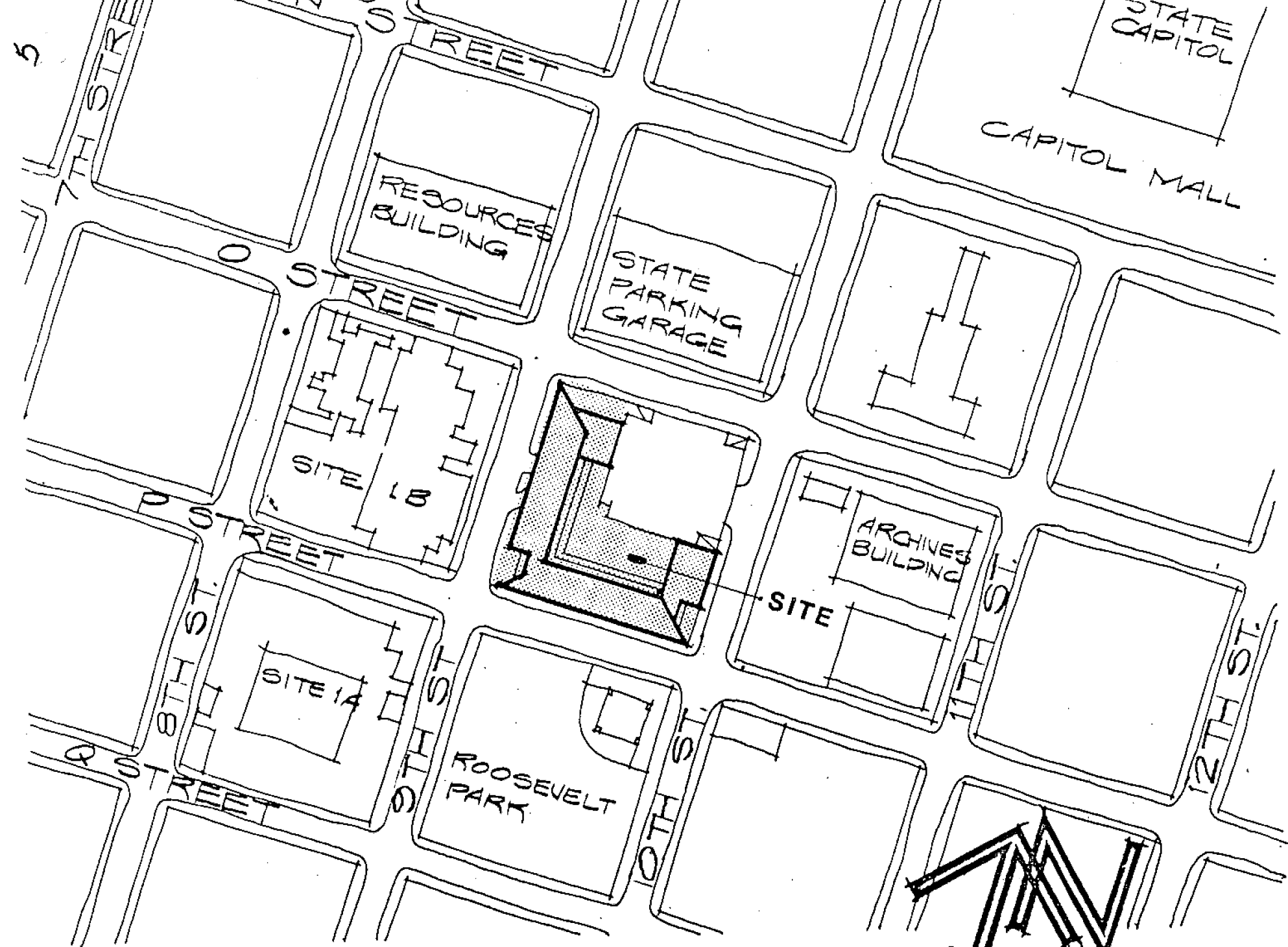

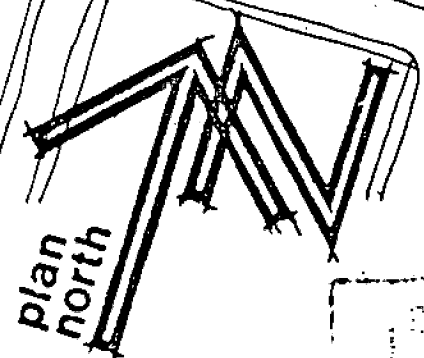
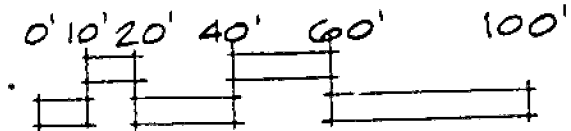

RESOLUTION GRANTING REVOCABLE ENCROACHMENT TO:
State of California

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That a revocable encroachment permit for the purpose of constructing two pedestrian warning signs and exposed aggregate concrete and tile sidewalk paving is hereby granted to State of Calif., Dept. of General Services, whose address is as follows: 915 Capital Mall, Suite 590 (OSA) Sacto., CA 95814

The encroachment area is described as follows:

An area between the corners of 9th and O Streets; 9th and P Streets; and 10th and P Streets in the block bounded by 9th and 10th, O and P Streets. An area approximately 860' x 16' or 13,760 sq. ft.

This permit is granted subject to the "General Provisions - Revocable Encroachment Permit", which were adopted by the City Council in Resolution No. 81-845 dated November 17, 1981, and the hereinafter specified special conditions, if any. This permit shall be effective only after the applicant files with the Risk Management & Insurance Division of the City of Sacramento, the insurance certificates required by the General Provisions.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

- 1. All construction shall comply with City of Sacramento, Standard Specifications, dated May 1, 1981.
- 2. All signs shall conform to the City Sign Ordinance.
- 3. Repair or Reconstruction of any section of exposed aggregate sidewalk, or paving stones shall be the responsibility of and paid by the State Department of General Services.
- 4. All construction shall conform to the plan on file in the City Engineer's office.
- 5. Permittee shall contact Bill Seeber of the Street Maintenance Division, 48 hours prior to beginning any construction in City Right of Way.
