SUBJECT: Metropolitan Arts Division - Authorization to Submit
Grant Application Under the California Arts Council's
Technical Assistance Program

SUMMARY

This report recommends authorization for the Metropolitan Arts Division to submit a grant application to the California Arts Council in the amount of \$30,000 (THIRTY THOUSAND DOLLARS) for the purpose of conducting a technical assistance program, January 1, 1982 through December 31, 1982.

BACKGROUND

Since 1978, the Sacramento Metropolitan Arts Commission has been conducting a technical assistance program funded through grants from the California Arts Council.

The 1982 Technical Assistance Program will provide: (1) art management workshops; (2) consultant services, on request, to artists and/or non-profit arts organizations; (3) a conference on survival of the individual artist and how organizations can best provide services to the artists; (4) a resource center with arts-related publications, slide, video and audio materials to be available on-site or as part of a traveling library; and (5) an arts hotline--a 24-hour telephone recording of current local arts events, performances, exhibits, classes and other cultural activities.

FINANCIAL DATA

The grant does not require additional City or County Funds. However, a match is required in funds other than State monies. The Metropolitan Arts Division intends to match the grant amount through corporate contributions and in kind contributions.
