

Resolution Ordering Work No.

3187

Resolved, that the public interest and convenience require, and the City Council of the City of Sacramento hereby orders, the following ~~work~~ work to be done, to-wit:

THE ~~XXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXX~~ CONSTRUCTION OF A STREET LIGHTING SYSTEM, complete on 55th Street, 56th Street and 57th Street from the center line of Fruitridge Road to the center line of 27th Avenue; 58th Street from the center line of Fruitridge Road to the Westerly production of the Northerly line of Lot 895 Tallac Village Unit No. 6 (as the same is shown on the official Plat thereof filed in the office of the Sacramento County Recorder); 27th Avenue from the Westerly line of 55th Street to the Southerly production of the Easterly line of Lot 895 of said Tallac Village Unit No. 6; Fruitridge Road from the Southerly production of the Westerly line of Lot 1116 of Tallac Village Unit No. 8 (as the same is shown on the official Plat thereof filed in the office of the Sacramento County Recorder), to the Southerly production of the Easterly line of Lot 883 of said Tallac Village Unit No. 6; Right of Way along the Northerly line of Lots 1079 and 1080 of said Tallac Village Unit No. 8,

in the City of Sacramento to the extent, with the materials and in the manner set forth in Resolution of Intention No. 3187, passed and adopted by said City Council on April 25th 1957, reference to which Resolution of Intention is hereby made for a description of said work and improvement.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to post conspicuously for five (5) days on or near the Council Chamber door of the City Council notice hereof, with specifications, inviting sealed proposals or bids for doing said work; and to publish twice a notice hereof, inviting sealed proposals or bids for doing said work, and referring to the specifications posted and on file, the said publication to be in the Sacramento Union a daily newspaper published and circulated in said City of Sacramento and hereby designated for that purpose.

All such proposals or bids shall be received by the City Clerk, at his office in the City Hall of said City, on the 6th day of June 19 57, between the hour of 4 o'clock p. m., and the hour of 5 o'clock p. m., and said day is hereby designated as the day on which at the hour of 8 o'clock p. m., the said proposals or bids shall be opened, all of which shall be specified in said notice, and said notice shall require with said proposals or bids a check certified by a responsible bank, payable to the City of Sacramento, for an amount not less than ten per cent (10%) of the aggregate of the proposal, or by a bond for the said amount, and so payable, signed by the bidder and two sureties, all as prescribed by law.
