10. **Requested Letter of Support for Grant Entitled "Arcade Creek – Tackling the Impact of Urbanization"**

11. **Parks and Recreation Master Plan Update (J.P. Tindell)**

J.P. Tindell, Master Plan Consultant, provided an update on the plan's schedule and progress including the work of the Master Plan Subcommittees. The report included information on the park user survey, telephone survey, Master Plan Vision, and Community-School partnerships.

Dr. G. Gary Manross, Consultant who completed a public survey by telephone as part of the Master Plan, answered questions from CAC members regarding the survey sampling size, content and findings.

A concern was raised regarding whether survey participants were clear on the distinction between City Tree Services for trees on city property versus private property. Dr. Manross explained the distinction was made clear to those surveyed; questions pertaining to tree maintenance applied only to trees on City property and in City parks, and excluded trees in front yards and private property.

Bill Maynard requested a copy of the final phone survey results. Dr. Manross responded that all CAC members will be provided a copy of the final survey report.

### **CAC MEMBERS IDEAS, QUESTIONS & ANNOUNCEMENTS**

Virginia Guadiana: Airport Little League site has been cleaned up. She thanked the Recreation Division for their work on cleaning up the site.

John Andrew announced he was invited as CAC Chair to attend the City Council's Personnel & Public Employee (P&PE) Committee meeting in October when the CAC's Commission proposal will be discussed. He will attend the meeting and keep CAC members informed.

John Andrew recommended the December meeting be held at the new joint use gym/multipurpose room at Didion School.
