SUBJECT: PARKING PROHIBITIONS ON A PORTION OF ALTA VALLEY WAY

LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT:

Alta Valley Way from 7818 Alta Valley Way to Bruceville Road. Council District 8.

RECOMMENDATION:

This report recommends that the City Council adopt the attached resolution to prohibit all parking on Alta Valley Way from 7818 Alta Valley Way to Bruceville Road.

SUMMARY:

This report recommends that all parking on a portion of Alta Valley Way be prohibited Exhibit (A). Large trucks park on this section of Alta Valley Way. Trucks parked along the curb make it difficult for employees and clients of nearby businesses to enter and exit driveways. Trucks often park for extended periods. Prohibiting all parking will relieve the parking congestion generated by these trucks.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

- Large trucks often park along Alta Valley Way.
- Street truck parking makes it difficult for clients and employees of nearby businesses to enter and exit driveways.
- Business owners have requested that all parking be removed along this segment of Alta Valley Way.
- Prohibiting all parking will relieve the parking congestion and the nuisance of having large trucks parked along the street.
- Businesses have adequate parking for employees and clients.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The cost to implement the recommended parking regulation is estimated to be \$200 for the installation of regulatory signs. Funds are available in the Street Division, Traffic Signs and Markings operating budget.

ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The Neighborhoods, Planning and Development Services Department, Office of Environmental Affairs has reviewed the project and has determined that this project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under Section 15301(c) of the CEQA guidelines.

POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:

This recommendation is consistent with the City Council priority of neighborhood revitalization and enhancement.



A RESOLUTION PROHIBITING ALL PARKING ON A PORTION OF ALTA VALLEY WAY

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 25.10.101 of the Sacramento City Code, when signs are erected giving notice thereof, no person shall stop, stand or park a vehicle at any time upon any of the streets described in resolutions duly adopted by the City Council.

THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO THAT:

All parking shall be prohibited on the following street:

- Alta Valley Way, from 7818 Alta Valley Way to Bruceville Road.
