

RESOLUTION NO. 2016-0326

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

September 20, 2016

APPROVING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE ELK GROVE UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT FOR THE START PROGRAM AT EDWARD HARRIS, JR. MIDDLE SCHOOL

BACKGROUND

- A. The Department of Parks and Recreation has operated the State's After-School Education and Safety (ASES) program under its START program at middle schools since 1999. Funding for the ASES program comes either directly to the City or from school districts that receive grants from the State Department of Education.
- B. School districts may provide ASES programs directly or contract with other providers to deliver services on their behalf.
- C. The Elk Grove Unified School District (EGUSD) has requested that the City continue to operate the ASES program at Edward Harris, Jr. Middle School in fiscal year 2016-17.
- D. All costs incurred by the City in the operation of the START program will be reimbursed by EGUSD. Therefore, no general fund support is required.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The Agreement with EGUSD to provide START services at Edward Harris, Jr. Middle School during fiscal year 2016-17 in the amount of \$122,381, attached as Exhibit A, is approved. The City Manager, or designee, is authorized to execute the Agreement.
- Section 2. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to adjust the necessary operating revenue and expenditure budgets to receive reimbursement of up to \$122,381 for the Elk Grove START program in fiscal year 2016-17.
