SUBJECT: Swimming Pool Agreement - Grant Joint Union High School District

SUMMARY

This report recommends that the City enter into an agreement with Grant Joint Union High School District for the use of their swimming pool during the next three summer sessions.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The City has conducted a recreational swim program at Grant Union High School and has had an agreement with the District since 1965. The service is an essential part of this Department's summer program for the Del Paso Heights community.

The Department of Parks and Community Services wishes to enter into an agreement for the 1984, 1985 and 1986 summer season for use of the District's swimming pool. This agreement allows the City to utilize the facility for recreational purposes to the benefit of the public. Significant terms of the agreement include:

1. schedule of use;
2. three-year agreement;
3. City appoints and pays for personnel;
4. City shall reimburse District for custodial services;
5. City is entitled to retain entrance fees to the pool;
6. agreement may be terminated upon ten days written notice by either party.


FINANCIAL DATA

The operational cost for the 1983 season was \$9,500. The 1984 season cost is expected to be \$10,800. Funds have been allocated in the FY 1983-84 budget and requested as part of the Recreation Division for FY 1984-85.


RECOMMENDATION
