Issued by the Mayor

Recognizing Wells Fargo Bank

WHEREAS, after many months of discussion, the Wells Fargo ATM went "live" at the Samuel C. Pannell Meadowview Community Center near the end of December 1997; and

WHEREAS, the significance of this event is substantial, in that it is the first time, in Wells Fargo's 10-state territory, that an ATM has been installed for community purposes rather than business purposes; and


