SUBJECT: "Gold Fever!" Audio Headset Lease Agreement

LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT:

Memorial Auditorium, Council District 1

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that Council, by Resolution, authorize the City Manager to execute an agreement between the City and Antenna Audio, Inc. for the provision of audio interpretive services for the "Gold Fever!" exhibition to be held at the Memorial Auditorium from August 1999 through October 1999.

SUMMARY:

The proposed rental of audio headsets for the "Gold Fever!" exhibition was included in a report approved by Council on January 19, 1999. Funds are available in the "Gold Fever!" exhibit budget to pay the vendor a charge of \$1.35 per rental of each headset. The total headset rental cost is estimated at \$148,500 which will be paid from admission revenues. The public will receive free use of the headsets as a part of the admission price to the exhibit.

COMMITTEE/COMMISSION ACTION:

None.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

- On January 19, 1999, Council approved a Resolution establishing a separate budget for the "Gold Fever!" exhibit. This budget included estimated costs of \$148,500 for fees paid to headset vendor, Antenna Audio, Inc. who will provide audio headsets for exhibit interpretation to visitors. This report requests authorization to execute the agreement with Antenna Audio, Inc.
- Under the proposed agreement, the "Gold Fever!" budget is charged a fee of \$1.35 per headset use which will be paid monthly from a portion of the exhibit admissions revenue. Visitors to the exhibit will receive free use of headsets as a part of the price of admission.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The total cost of the audio rentals is estimated at \$148,500 which will be offset by a portion of the revenues from admissions.

ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:

It can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility the execution of the proposed agreement may have a significant effect on the environment, therefore, the proposed agreement is exempt from CEQA pursuant to Section 15061(b)(3) of the California Environmental Quality Act.

POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:

The execution of the proposed audio agreement with Antenna Audio, Inc. is a necessary component of the "Gold Fever!" exhibit, the production of which is consistent with City policy to encourage activities of entertainment, cultural and historic interest.

ESBD CONSIDERATIONS:

Antenna Audio is not an ESBD vendor, but is the sole source for the audio services and equipment necessary for the "Gold Fever!" exhibit.
