## Acknowledging the Sacramento Zoological Society's Partnership in Stormwater Pollution Prevention

**WHEREAS**, knowing that every living thing needs water, that animals can become endangered when they do not have clean water available for survival, and that city storm drains flow directly to our natural water ways, the Sacramento Zoological Society has partnered with the City of Sacramento Department of Utilities Stormwater Management Program to educate residents on stormwater pollution prevention; and

**WHEREAS**, as a partner in stormwater pollution prevention, the Sacramento Zoological Society has agreed to provide space for an interactive display sign which will promote stormwater pollution prevention awareness at the Sacramento Zoo and provide space for, and maintain, a stormwater pollution prevention playground which will attract the 400,000 Sacramento Zoo visitors to the stormwater pollution prevention display; and

**WHEREAS**, in addition, the Sacramento Zoological Society will distribute stormwater pollution prevention educational material at the stormwater display, through the Zoomobile classroom outreach program, teacher training workshops, and school field trips.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Mayor and Council of the City of Sacramento, that we do hereby commend the Sacramento Zoological Society for its Partnership in the Stormwater Pollution Prevention program and recognize them for their dedication and commitment to the quality of life for Sacramento residents.
