**SUBJECT: SALE OF SURPLUS FIRE TRUCK TO GALT FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT**

**LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT:** City-wide; All districts

**STAFF RECOMMENDATION:**

The Procurement Services Division, on behalf of the Maintenance Services Division (Fleet Operations) of the Department of Public Works, recommends that the City Council adopt the attached Resolution authorizing the sale of a City Fire Truck, Equipment No. 5586, to the Galt Fire Protection District.

**SUMMARY:**

A City aerial ladder fire truck with pump (City Equipment No. 5586) has been removed from active service at the request of the Fire Department because it no longer appropriately serves their needs. The Maintenance Services Division (Fleet Operations) has received an offer from the Galt Fire Protection District to purchase the truck for the amount of \$207,800.00.

**BACKGROUND:**

The Fire Department has requested that a 1987 Pierce Aerial Ladder fire truck with pump (City Equipment No. 5586) be removed from service and disposed of, because it is no longer required due to the reduction in the number of truck companies and because the overall size of the unit limits which fire stations can accommodate it. The Maintenance Services Division (Fleet Operations) has received an offer from the Galt Fire Protection District to purchase the subject truck for the amount of \$207,800.00. This value was determined by considering the original purchase cost, anticipated life remaining, and the current book value of the vehicle. Revenue from the sale will be used, in combination with additional fleet replacement funds, to purchase other replacement fire apparatus that more appropriately meets the current needs of the Sacramento Fire Department.

The alternative method of disposition for surplus equipment of this type is sale by public auction or sealed bid. Based on the method used to determine the price at which the Galt Fire Protection District has offered to purchase the unit, it is unlikely that sale by either auction or sealed bid would yield a significantly higher sum. Additionally, this sale will assist a public fire organization in our region to add needed equipment to its fleet at a fair and reasonable cost.

**FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:**

As noted above, the value of the subject fire truck, \$207,800.00 was determined by considering the original purchase cost, anticipated life remaining, and the current book value of the vehicle. The proceeds from the sale will be used, in combination with additional fleet replacement funds, to purchase other replacement fire apparatus.

**POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:**

This proposed sale is in accordance with the provisions of Sacramento City Code §12.05.131(E) which provides for the sale of surplus City property to other public agencies. It is also in concert with Council policy to work cooperatively with other public agencies.


**ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:**

Ongoing administrative and maintenance activities, such as purchases of supplies, equipment or materials which are not made for purposes of a public works construction project, do not constitute a "project" and are exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). CEQA Guidelines, Sections 15061(b)(1), 15378(b)(3).

**MBE/WBE EFFORTS:**

Because this transaction does not involve the purchase of goods or services for the City, M/WBE efforts are not applicable.
