SUMMARY:

The subject project, as a part of the City's Capital Improvement Program has been advertised for bids. Bids have been received and the City Engineer hereby recommends bid award.

BACKGROUND:

On June 9, 1982 the City Council approved plans and specifications for THE DEVELOPMENT OF OAK PARK COMMUNITY CENTER - PHASE II and bids were received and opened by the City Clerk in the Council Chambers on June 29, 1982. Bids received are as follows:

FINANCIAL:

In F.Y. 1980/81 the City Council approved \$250,000 of Community Development Block Grant funds and \$11,696 of General Revenue Sharing funds for the subject project. Total amount currently available for this project is \$247,708.46. The estimated construction cost was \$214,475.00.

RECOMMENDATION:

The City Engineer recommends that the low bid of Cioli Construction in the amount of \$191,605.75 be accepted.
