SUBJECT: SUMP 8 SWITCHGEAR REPLACEMENT PROJECT (PN: WI21) - AWARD CONTRACT TO CLYDE STEAGALL FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$132,983.

LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT:

The construction funded by this project will affect Sump 8 which is located at 5975 64th Street within Council District 6 (see enclosed map).

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends that the City Council adopt the attached resolution to accept the responsive low bid from Clyde Steagall for an amount not to exceed \$132,983 and award the contract.

SUMMARY

Bids were received from five (5) contractors and opened by the City Clerk on September 15, 1999. Clyde Steagall was the lowest responsive bidder with a bid of \$132,983.

Sump 8 Switchgear Replacement Project - Contract Award (PN: WI21)

BACKGROUND

Sump 8 is a drainage sump station that is designed to collect and pump storm drainage into Morrison Creek through a 36" forced main from Drainage Basin #8. New switchgear and control equipment will be installed as part of the Department of Utilities' effort to upgrade out-dated electrical equipment at its facilities. The original switchgear was installed in 1957 and is difficult to maintain due to its age. The new equipment will incorporate a programmable logic controller which gives the City enhanced monitoring and control capabilities and is very useful during heavy storm events. In addition, this facility will be outfitted with equipment to allow connection to an emergency generator if there is a SMUD power failure.

This project was advertised and bids were received on September 15, 1999. The bids are summarized below:

- Staff recommends contract award to Clyde Steagall, which exceeded the ESBE goals.
- The estimated completion date is March 3, 2000.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS

The total project cost including design, construction, inspection and contingency is \$155,908 based on the bid of \$132,983. There are sufficient funds in the Sump 8 Switchgear Replacement Project (425-500-WI21-4820) to award this contract and complete the project.

ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION

The Planning Services Division, Environmental Section, has reviewed the project and has determined that this project is exempt from CEQA under Section 15301(b) of the CEQA Guidelines. A notice of categorical exemption was filed with the County Clerk on July 7, 1998.

POLICY CONSIDERATIONS

This action is in conformance with City Code sections, 58.03.304, & 58.03.301, which provides that the City Council may award competitively bid contracts to the lowest responsible bidder and "advertising for bidding" requirements respectively.

ESBD CONSIDERATIONS

This project included participation goals of 20% for emerging and small business enterprises as required by Ordinance 99-007 and Resolution 99-055, relating to ESBD participation goals and policies, adopted by the City Council on February 9, 1999. The responsive low bidder, Clyde Steagall, exceeded the ESBE goals with a participation level of 90.65%.





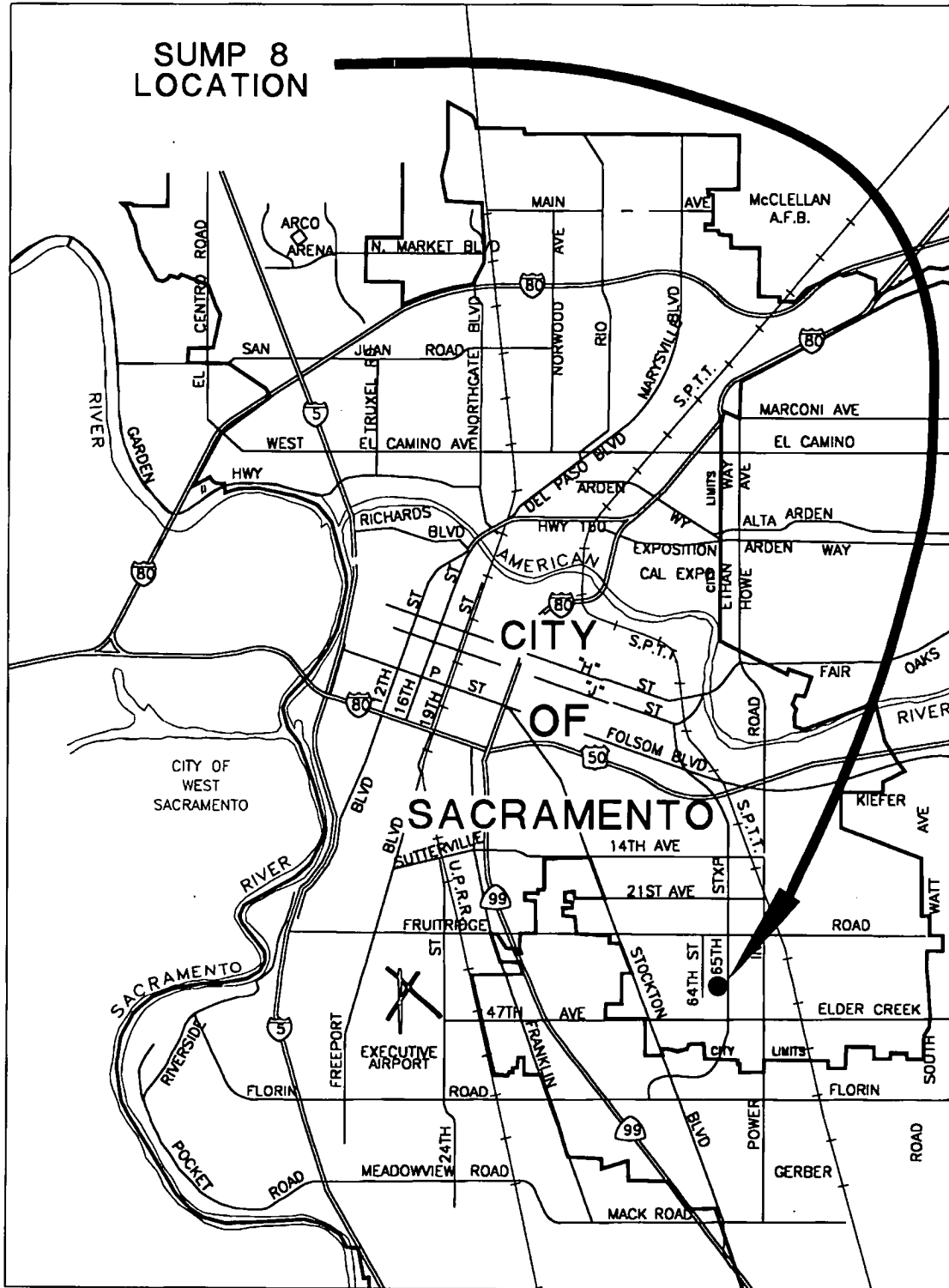
