EXECUTE A CONTRACT FOR RADIO EQUIPMENT MAINTENANCE SERVICES

BACKGROUND

- A. Motorola, Inc. has provided radio maintenance services for the City of Sacramento for the last five years. All services have been provided in accordance with the contract's Scope of Services, Terms, and Conditions (City Agreement 2002-219). Motorola, Inc. provides essential City services that are necessary to maintain the City's high public health and safety standards.
- B. On March 5, 2007, Procurement Services competitively bid the replacement contract, and Motorola, Inc. was found to be the apparent low bidder. However, Motorola, Inc. also submitted additional terms and conditions with their bid that were deemed substantial in nature, resulting in a non-responsive bid.
- C. On May 29, 2007, the City Council approved rejecting bids, suspending competitive bidding, extending the current contract for 6 months with Motorola, and authorized the City Manager to conduct negotiations with Motorola to establish a new contract for radio equipment maintenance services (Reso 2007-317).

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a contract with Motorola, Inc. for Radio Equipment Maintenance Services, for an initial six month term (January 1, 2007 through June 30, 2007) for an amount not to-exceed \$250,000.
- Section 2. The City Manager is hereby authorized to extend the contract for four additional one year terms for an annual amount not to exceed \$450,000.
