SUBJECT: Advance Flashers at Various Locations (PN:SD36) - Contract Award

SUMMARY

This project has been advertised for bids. Bids have been received and contract award is recommended.

BACKGROUND

This project will install advance warning flashers and the associated regulatory traffic signs and safety lighting for Norwood Avenue bypass at Norwood Avenue and Grove Avenue, at Norwood Avenue and Lindley Drive, and at Rio Linda Boulevard and South Avenue. The flashers on the Norwood Avenue bypass are being installed to warn of curves ahead; the other two are to reinforce fairway stop signs.

On May 2, 1989, the City Council approved the plans and specifications for this project. Bids were received and opened by the City Clerk on May 23, 1989. The bids received were:

Richard A. Heaps Electrical Contractor, Inc.	\$46,910
May-Han Electric, Inc., dba M & M Electric	\$52,374
Steiny and Co., Inc.	\$61,960
J. K. Hayes, Inc.	\$66,659

The engineer's estimated construction cost was \$40,200. The estimated project completion date is November 15, 1989.

FINANCIAL DATA

Sufficient funds are available for this project. The estimated total project cost, including all planning, design and construction costs is \$60,800. The current budget is \$65,000, which was approved in the Capital Improvement Program from Gas Tax Funds (202). The funds available for this project amount to \$32,600 as of June 13, 1989.

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POLICY CONSIDERATIONS

None.

MBE/WBE EFFORTS

Plans and specifications were sent to nineteen (19) plan rooms and construction services organizations for publication and use by the construction industry in Northern California. There are four (4) organizations on the distribution list that are directly involved with MBE/WBE contractors. There were five (5) planholders for this project, none of whom are certified MBE/WBE contractors.

RECOMMENDATION


It is recommended that the City Council accept the low bid of Richard A. Heaps Electrical Contractor, Inc. in the amount of \$46,910, and award the contract.


