



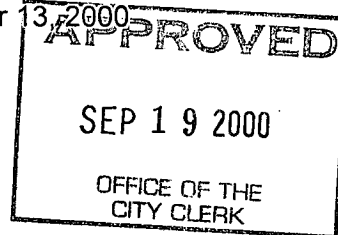

SUBJECT: APPLICATION FOR LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT BLOCK GRANT

LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT: CITY-WIDE

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the City Council adopt the attached resolution authorizing the Program Contact Person to apply to the United States Department of Justice, Office of Justice Planning for the 2000 allotment of the Local Law Enforcement Block Grant (LLEBG).

SUMMARY:

This year, the City is applying for \$901,329 which requires a match of City funds in the amount of \$100,148. The match is already included in the Police Department budget. The funding period is from October 1, 2000 to September 30, 2001. The Police Department will return to Council for approval of the use of the LLEBG funds.

BACKGROUND:

The purpose of the Local Law Enforcement Block Grants Program is to provide units of local government with funds to underwrite projects to reduce crime and improve public safety.

ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:

This activity does not constitute a "project" and is therefore exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act(CEQA), CEQA Guidelines Sections 15061(b)(1),15378(b)(3).

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The LLEBG requires a City match of \$100,148 which is already included in the Police Department budget.


POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:

Application for LLEBG funding is consistent with past practice and allows the Police Department additional funds to effectively pursue its goals.

EMERGING AND SMALL BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM CONSIDERATIONS:

No services or supplies are being purchased at this time.
