

RESOLUTION NO. 3278

ADOPTED BY THE SACRAMENTO CITY COUNCIL ON

July 3rd, 1958

WHEREAS, Two petitions have been filed with the City Council requesting that proceedings be adopted for the ~~improvement~~ ~~construction~~ construction of a Water Distribution System, complete, on 29th Avenue from Franklin Boulevard, Westerly to the Eastern Right of Way line of the Western Pacific Railroad and 28th Street from the Southerly line of 26th Avenue to the Northerly line of Fruitridge Road,

in the City of Sacramento, and


WHEREAS, the signers of said petitions state that they are all of the Owners of more than 60% of the area liable for Assessment for said work and improvement, and they expressly "WAIVE" the provisions of Division 4 of the "Streets and Highways Code of the State of California", (The Special Assessment Investigation, Limitation and Majority Protest Act of 1931), as amended, and all investigations, proceedings, and reports provided for therein, and

WHEREAS the said petitions have been checked by the City Engineer's Office and found that the WAIVER is signed by the Owners of more than 60% of the area liable for Assessment for said work.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council that the said petitions are hereby approved and granted, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council hereby finds and determines that the WAIVER in said petitions is signed by the Owners of more than 60% of the area liable for said work and improvement and hereby directs that proceedings for said work be authorized as provided in Division 7 of the said Streets and Highways Code, THE IMPROVEMENT ACT OF 1911.
