

CENTRAL CITY WAYFINDING PROJECT (PN: KC86) – MAKE FINDINGS, APPROVE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS, ACCEPT BID, AND AWARD CONTRACT

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO THAT:

- Section 1: Pursuant to Section 33445 of the Health and Safety Code of the State of California, the City finds that:
 - a. The design and development of the Central City Wayfinding Signage Project ("Project") is of benefit to the Merged Downtown Redevelopment Project Area;
 - b. There is no other reasonable means of financing the Project available to the community except for redevelopment area tax increment proceeds;
 - c. The use of redevelopment tax increment proceeds for the Project will result in the elimination of blighting influences of inadequate and dilapidated infrastructure inside the Project Area and the Project is consistent with the implementation plan adopted pursuant to Health and Safety Code of the State of California, Section 33490;
- Section 2: the City approves the use of previously allocated funds for the design and development of the Central City Wayfinding Project;
- The Plans and Specifications for the Central City Wayfinding Project (PN: KC86) are approved;
- The low bid of Western Sign Company in the amount of \$492,035 is accepted; and
- The City Manager is authorized and directed to execute a contract with Western Sign Company in the amount of \$492,035 for the Central City Wayfinding Project (PN: KC86).
